

Winterizing your motorcycle.

Carburetor equipped bikes:

- If possible, Change the oil and transmission fluid.
- Wash and clean your bike.
- Inflate tires to proper pressure.
- Fill the tank with gasoline treated with fuel stabilizer.
- Start the bike and run until warm.
- Shut off the gas at the fuel petcock.
- When the engine stops, turn off engine and wait until cool.
- Remove spark plugs and spray WD-40 or light oil spray in each cylinder.
- Reinstall spark plugs finger tight.
- Check battery connections and attach battery tender.
- Polish bike and cover.

Fuel injected bikes:

- If possible, Change the oil and transmission fluid
- Wash and clean your bike.
- Inflate tires to proper pressure.
- Fill the tank with gasoline treated with fuel stabilizer.
- Start the bike and run until warm.
- Turn ignition off and wait until cool.
- Remove spark plugs and spray WD-40 or light oil spray in each cylinder.
- Reinstall spark plugs finger tight.
- Check battery connections and attach battery tender.
- Polish bike and cover.

If you have a center stand, get the weight off the tires.

In the spring, make sure you tighten the plugs, check the tires, and warm the bike up before riding.
